COSY COWL KNIT- ALONG



MATERIALS

- Chunky yarn (at least two balls)
- Knitting needles in the corresponding size
- Scrap yarn
- Crochet hook
- Tapestry needle
- Scissors



THIS PATTERN IS DESIGNED SO YOU CAN UNLEASH YOUR CREATIVITY!

It is what I call a template pattern, which means that you can either knit it exactly as described here, OR you can substitute your own choice of yarn, needles and stitch pattern to create something that is completely unique to you!

CAST ON

Using the provisional cast on method and your scrap yarn, cast on between 20-40 stitches. How many you cast on depends on your yarn; the chunkier the yarn, the fewer stitches you need. For mine, I cast on 20.

PATTERN

Row 1: Knit all stitches

Row 2: K2, Purl to last 2 stitches, K2

Repeat rows 1 & 2 until the cowl is long enough to fit over your head, making sure to finish after knitting row 2.

If you want a longer cowl or an infinity scarf, continue knitting until it is the length you desire.

CAST OFF

Slowly unravel the Provisional Cast On from left to right, picking up the live stitches on your other knitting needle as you work your way across.

Graft the two sets of live stitches together using the Kitchener stitch, to create a cosy, seamless cowl!
